Hummingbird Feeding Cheat Sheet

Homemade Nectar Recipe

- 1 part white granulated sugar
- 4 parts water
- Example: 1 cup sugar + 4 cups water

Instructions:

- 1. Heat water to help dissolve sugar (no need to boil).
- 2. Stir in sugar until completely dissolved.
- 3. Cool completely before filling your feeder.
- 4. Store extra nectar in the fridge (up to 1 week).

Never use:

- Honey
- Brown, raw, or organic sugar
- Artificial sweeteners
- Red food coloring

Cleaning Guidelines

- Clean feeder every 2-3 days in hot weather
- Clean weekly in cooler weather
- Use hot water only (no soap)
- Scrub well to remove mold or residue

Best Practices

- Hang feeders in partial shade
- Place near flowers or shrubs
- Put feeders out in early spring
- Keep feeders up 2 weeks after last sighting in fall

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Common Mistakes to Avoid

- Letting nectar get cloudy or fermented
- Using colored or flavored nectar
- Using soap when cleaning
- Forgetting to refill or clean regularly

Quick Tip

Migration is not delayed by feeders. They help hummingbirds fuel up for the journey!
